




Analysing Your Story



Matching Visual and Audio

Story Analysis Questions

- Q: What are the main plot elements of your story (what happens first, what happens next)

- Q: What is the main situation that gets resolved or question that gets answered in your story

(Could be the main point of conflict, the point of tension) *Remember you want to refer to this – to get your reader interested - but not give it away.*



Story Analysis Questions

- Who are the main characters in the story – what do they look like, what sort of clothes would they wear, where would they live, what sort of people are they, are they easily likable, good or bad, happy or sad....



Story Analysis Questions

- What is the setting for the story; that is to say where does the story take place. Is it indoors or outdoors, in a home or business setting, in a particular country or culture or at a particular time of the year?

- Now that you have answered these questions, give some thought to the types of images, sounds, music, words that can be used to depict these.
- What search terms might you use to find them online?

- What snappy words or phrases might you use to introduce your story plot, characters and the situation cliff hanger that will get your audience wanting to know more?
