


# DEPTHS IN METRES



### RESTRICTED SPEED AREAS

Department of Transport (DoT):  
Limits the speed of motor boats to that of **Five (5) knots** within the following areas:

- THOMSON BAY:** All those waters of Thomson Bay bounded by lines drawn from Bathurst Point Lighthouse in a 058° direction for 330 metres from the foreshore to the Duck Rock Light Beacon, thence in a 146° direction for 1,132 metres to the eastern beacon of Inner Kingston Reef, thence to Phillip Rock, thence to the western extremity of Natural Jetty.
- PARAKEET, GEORDIE and LONGREACH BAYS:** All those waters of Parakeet, Geordie and Longreach Bays bounded by lines drawn from North Point in a due north direction for 130 metres thence in a easterly direction to Monday Rock beacon thence south to Bathurst Point Lighthouse.
- MAJORIE BAY, NARROW NECK and STARK BAY:** All the waters of Marjorie Bay, Narrow Neck and Stark Bay south-east of a line commencing at a point 60 metres north of Hayward Cape and thence running in a 064° direction to Crayfish Rock at the north-east end of Stark Bay.

### LIMITATION OF SPEED


A person shall not drive a motor boat at a speed exceeding **EIGHT (8) knots**, or water ski-

- without the approval of the Department of Transport (DoT)
  - in any water having a depth of less than 3 metres; or
  - within 45 metres of a river bank or low water mark;
- in or through a mooring area;
- within 15 metres of a vessel under weigh;
- within 45 metres of-
  - a moored vessel;
  - a person in the water; or
  - a jetty or wharf; or
- through an arch of a bridge (except those which are gazetted).

### CLOSED WATERS AREAS

- All the waters of Thomson Bay contained within an area commencing at a point on the foreshore 400 metres east of the Army Jetty extending 40 metres north to seaward, thence in an easterly direction for 300 metres, thence in a southerly direction to the shore. The extremities of the area are marked by signs on the foreshore.
- All those waters of Thomson Bay contained within an area commencing on the foreshore 140 metres south-east of the Hotel Jetty, extending along the foreshore offshore in a south-easterly direction for 90 metres and extending parallel with the foreshore for 40 metres between the start and finishing points.
- All the waters of Thomson Bay contained between Stark Jetty and the Main Wharf and extending for a distance of 60 metres eastwards from the sea wall.
- All the waters contained within the area known as the "Basin". No boat shall approach within 90 metres of the

SPEARGUNS, harpoons, Hawaiian slings and all other pointed instruments shall not be used for the taking of any fish whatsoever around Rottnest Island. Refer to map above. Rottnest Island Authority by-laws prohibit spearguns, etc. on the Island. NET FISHING is prohibited in all waters within 800 metres of Rottnest Island. Refer to map above. FISHING PROHIBITED - the taking of any fish by any means whatsoever is not permitted in the areas indicated. Refer to map above, this Chart and <http://www.rottnestisland.com/>.
