

## Bibliography Marking Guide – Year 7-12

This is a draft guide only.

### Marks - 5/5 (or 3/3)

Follows the correct APA 7 formatting as per the MLC referencing guide (i.e. author, date, title, place of publication, as well as punctuation and capitalisations used correctly). Uses an extensive quantity and range of different freely available and library accessed information sources (i.e. 4 or more different source types such as books, encyclopedia articles [Britannica], journal articles, magazine/ news articles, websites, videos [ClickView and/or YouTube], and images). Image references are included (i.e. photographs and maps). Uses up-to-date information where applicable. All entries are reliable sources. URL formatting is consistent. It is acceptable for URL's or DOI's to be live links that are blue/ underlined if the work is published online, or not if published in printed.

## Marks – 4-4.5/5 (or 2.5/3)

Follows the correct formatting of APA 7 all or most of the time. Evidence of using Citefast effectively (or other reference generator) but hasn't checked against the MLC Referencing Guide or uses the incorrect format for the source type (eg uses a website format for an article on a news or magazine site) or some details are missing. Uses an extensive quantity and range of freely available and library accessed source types. Images are referenced. Entries are reliable sources. URL's are formatted consistently.

### Marks – 3-3.5/5 (or 2/3)

Uses correct APA 7 formatting most of the time. Evidence of using Citefast (or other reference generator) but hasn't manually checked for accuracy of details or uses the incorrect format for the source type. Details from some of the citations are missing. Uses a range of different freely available and library accessed information sources. Imaged are not referenced. Sources are mostly reliable. URL formatting is inconsistent

## Marks – 2.5/5 (or 1.5/3)

Uses correct APA 7 formatting some of the time. Some evidence of using Citefast (or other reference generator) but some details are missing. Uses some different source types but only ones freely available on the internet (i.e. no print or digital library accessed resources). Uses the incorrect format for some citations (i.e. website for a news article). Images are not referenced. Some unreliable sources are used, ie includes google search urls in citations, uses Wikipedia or sources with no credible author. Some or all indenting may be missing.

Marks – 2/5 (or 1/3)

Follows APA 7 formatting correctly some of the time. Some evidence of using Citefast (or other reference generator) but hasn't manually checked details. Pieces of information are missing. Uses a limited number of source types and the incorrect format. Images are not referenced. Some unreliable sources are used, ie includes google search urls in citations, uses Wikipedia or sources with no credible author. Some or all indenting may be missing.

Marks – 1-1.5/5 (or .5/3)

Doesn't follow APA formatting. Only lists URL's of one or two types of free online source types (i.e. freely available websites, online news articles, YouTube videos). Images are not referenced. Some unreliable sources are used, ie includes google search urls in citations, uses Wikipedia or sources with no credible author. Some or all indenting may be missing. Not in alphabetical order.
